2. Read **2 Corinthians 6:12 – 7:1**. What are some of the accommodations you have made (or are tempted to make) to the world's values and priorities that can keep you from being as close to God in your daily life as you know you could and should be?
3. Read **Psalms 86:1-7**. What motivation and encouragement for prayer do you gain from this passage?
4. Read **Mark 1:35**. What specific steps will you take this week to increase your focused, concentrated and uninterrupted prayer appointments with God?
5. Read **Psalms 1:1-3**. What is the difference between the days which begin with time in the Scriptures and those days in which your Bible is entirely neglected?
